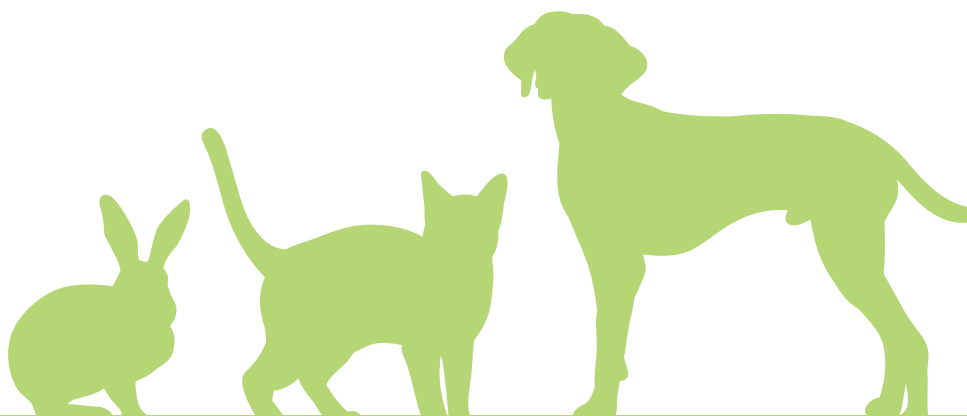

- Receding gums
- Reluctance to chew or eat
