

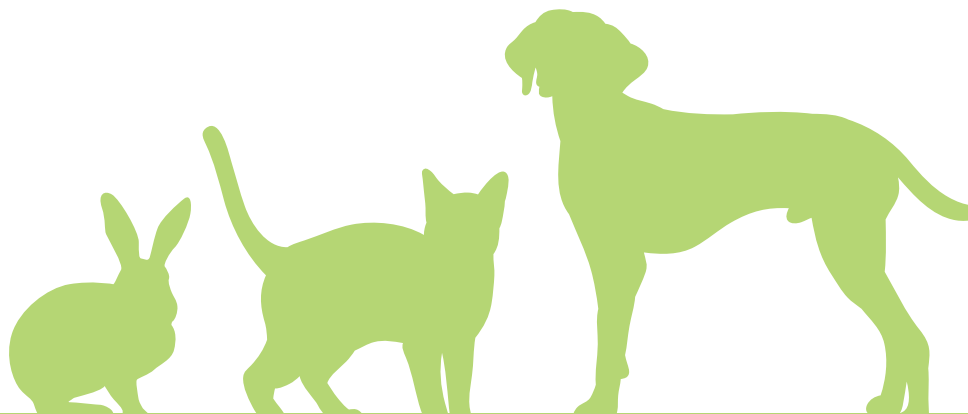
Fleas, ticks & worms check
